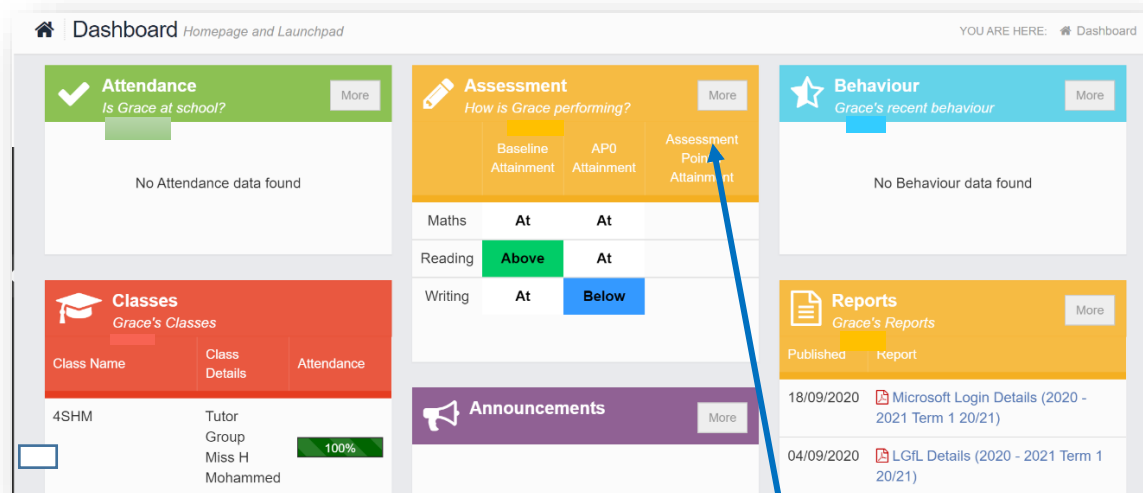


## Assessment update, assessment point 1 – 2024-25

Your child's class teacher has assessed your child's attainment in reading, writing and mathematics against the national curriculum for their age group.

child's attainment and progress will be assessed in the following ways:

Descriptor	What the descriptor means for:		For quick reference a colour will be used:
	Progress	Attainment (SS= Standardised score)	
Well below	n/a	SS below 85	Pink
Below	Less than expected	SS 85-94	Blue
At	expected	SS 95 - 115	White
Above	More than expected	SS 116+	Green

So for example, the child above:

- In mathematics the child has made more than expected progress and is working at the expected standard for their age group with a standardised score of 100.
- In reading the child has made average progress but is working below expected standards for their age group, with a standardised score of 85.
- In writing the child made expected progress but is working below year group expectations. There is no standardised score as the pupils are not tested in writing.

Assessment point 2 will be at the end of June. Pupils in Year 6 will sit statutory tests in May.
