What are Francophone countries?

Francophone countries are those where French is spoken as a national language. These countries were conquered by France and became French colonies in the 17th century. There are many Francophone countries around the world, especially in the continents of Europe, Africa and North America.

Grammar rules:

How do I make a negative sentence? e.g. I do not speak English.

We wrap the **ne** and **pas** and around the verb - this is sometimes known as a 'negative sandwich':

Je **ne** <u>parle</u> **pas** anglais.
