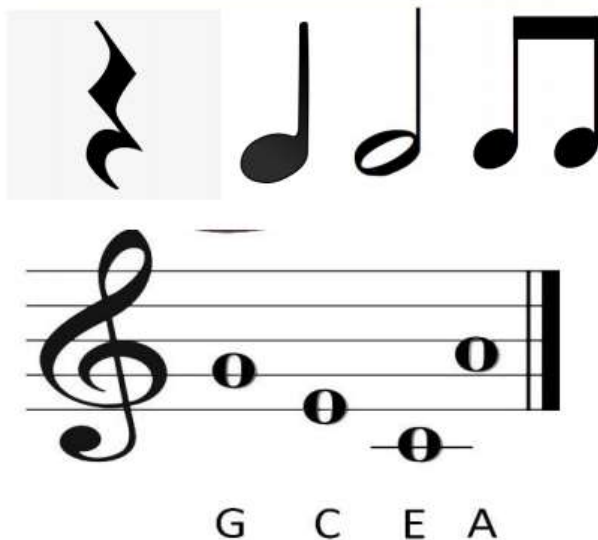

## Must—know knowledge

- Ukulele is an instrument which originated from Hawaii.
- It has 4 strings: G, C, E, A (Green, Cows, Eat, Aliens).
- Rhythmic notation: crotchet, quavers, minim, crotchet rest (recap from Yr3)
- A chord is when you play more than one note at the same time.
- Name the key parts of the Ukulele.
- C major chord— 3rd finger, 3rd fret on the A string (diagram below).
