The war was fought by Germany, Italy and Japan; and the Allied nations including Britain and USA.

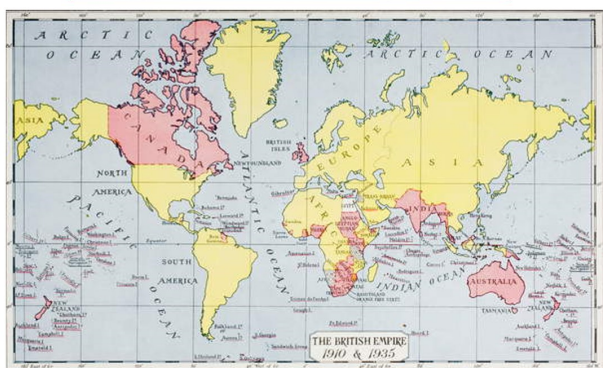
Women played a various important roles in the Armed forces.
